

THE CONCERTO ...

- ... is notated in a free form: a sequence of emotional states.
- The so-called "Konzertstück" (Concert Piece) is essentially his third piano concerto.
- Weber had planned from the start to compose the work in a minor key, but at the same time was concerned that this would not be well received by the audience.
- He therefore assumed a programmatic content, a dramatic love story in a crusader milieu, which should motivate the music, but which he kept secret.
